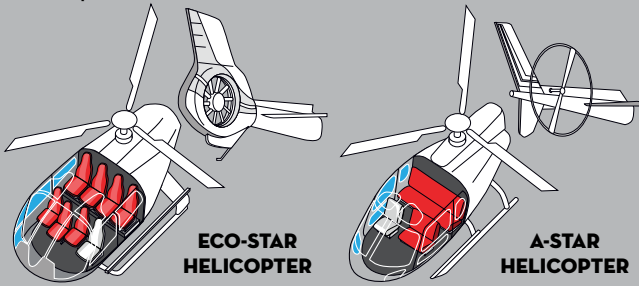


WHY CHOOSE THE ECO-STAR?

GRAND CANYON LANDING

Soar into the sky and experience a breathtaking flight over Hoover Dam, Lake Mead, Fortification Hill and many other awe-inspiring views. Next, experience the Grand Canyon and enjoy a bird's-eye view as you fly through this natural wonder. Descend and land 3,500 feet inside the Grand Canyon on the Hualapai Indian Reservation and enjoy beverages, a light snack and a champagne toast 300 feet above the Colorado River. As you make your way back to Las Vegas, fly through and observe beautiful Black Canyon. The Grand Canyon Landing tour lasts approximately 4.5 hours (hotel to hotel).

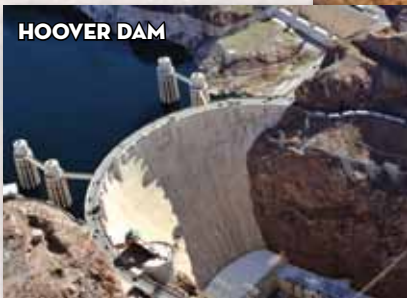

GRAND CANYON AIR TOUR

Sit back and relax as you experience this spectacular air-only excursion through the Grand Canyon. Ascend into the sky and enjoy aerial highlights including Hoover Dam, Lake Mead, Lake Las Vegas, Fortification Hill, Temple Rock and Iceberg Canyon. Keep an eye open for wildlife along the way as big horn sheep, mountain lions and wild horses roam free. On your flight back to the Las Vegas valley, you will fly over historic Boulder City. The Grand Canyon Air tour lasts approximately 4 hours (hotel to hotel).

WESTERN JOURNEY

Your excursion begins with a scenic flight over Lake Mead, Hoover Dam, Fortification Hill and Temple Rock. Fly through the majestic Grand Canyon as you head towards your primary destination - Grand Canyon West. Upon landing at GCW, you will have approximately 3.5 hours of ground time to explore and take in the various overlooks and highlights of Grand Canyon West. Enjoy a meal at a viewpoint of your choice. The Western Journey lasts approximately 7 hours (hotel to hotel).

EAGLE POINT

Skywalk – A true engineering feat! A glass walking surface that suspends more than 4,000 feet above the Grand Canyon; extending more than 70 feet away from the edge.

Native American Village - Walking tour of authentic Native American dwellings.

Amphitheater - Live Native American performances from multiple tribes throughout the day.

GUANO POINT

“Highpoint Hike” - Offering breathtaking panoramic canyon views of the Grand Canyon and Colorado River.

Historic Tram - Remnants of a tram that stretched 8,800 feet across the canyon to a guano mine discovered in the 1930's.

HUALAPAI RANCH

Horseback Riding - Several horseback riding options are available including a 30-minute trail ride that takes you to the canyon rim or an arena ride.

Western Hospitality - Cowboy entertainment, wagon rides, roping demonstrations and much more.
